

Bluebeam Tool Set Import Guide

For Construction Markup Tools BTX packs

1. Install a tool set

Use either method below. Importing copies the tool set into your Revu user profile.

Method A - double-click

1. Extract the downloaded ZIP file. 2. Double-click the .btx file. 3. If Windows asks which app to use, choose Bluebeam Revu. 4. Revu opens and adds the set to the Tool Chest.

Method B - import from Revu

1. Open Revu. 2. Open the Tool Chest panel. 3. Select Tool Chest settings, then Manage Tool Sets. 4. Select Import. 5. Choose the .btx file and confirm.

Confirm the import

In the Tool Chest, locate the set whose name begins with CMT. Drag a symbol onto a test PDF. Select the markup and confirm its Subject and Label appear in the Properties or Markups List.

2. Use symbols for counts

The included symbols are count-enabled. Place the same symbol repeatedly to build device quantities. In the Markups List, group or filter by Subject and Label, then export the list to CSV if you need a schedule or estimating worksheet.

Keep scale and appearance consistent

These device symbols are intended as plan markers. Resize a symbol only when your drawing standard requires it. Use the same size and colour convention throughout a project so counts and reviews remain clear.

3. Files and compatibility

Plumbing & Drainage	cmt-plumbing-v1.btx

The packs were generated and import-tested with Revu 21.9.0 on Windows 11. BTX is Bluebeam's tool-set exchange format. If your organisation uses an older Revu release, test the free sample before purchasing.

4. Troubleshooting

Tool set does not appear: restart Revu, then import through Manage Tool Sets. Confirm you extracted the ZIP before importing.

Windows opens the wrong app: right-click the BTX file, choose Open with, and select Bluebeam Revu.

Symbols are read-only: use Import rather than Add if you want a local editable copy. Shared-network sets may be intentionally read-only.

Need a clean reinstall: in Manage Tool Sets, remove the affected CMT set and import the original BTX again.

5. Licence and support

A purchase licenses the buyer to use the supplied symbols in their own commercial project documents. Do not resell, redistribute, publish, sublicense, or provide the source BTX files to unrelated third parties. Bluebeam Revu software is not included.
